A Sales Table Application/Contract is attached for you. Please feel free to copy it for any other interested artisans you may know, and be sure to make a copy for yourself after you have completed and signed your own contract.

This is a handcrafted ONLY show and is advertised as such. Some guidelines for you:

ACCEPTABLE:

1. A doll or metal miniature manufactured by someone else or poured from a commercial mold, but painted/enhanced/dressed by the Dealer/Artisan who signs the contract.
2. Commercial or natural components combined into a new entity, e.g. a flower arrangement in a basket, vase or landscaped scene.
3. Kits to manufacture an item designed by and with instructions written by the Dealer/Artisan presenting the kit where others commercially manufacture some but not all components.

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

1. Items crafted by artisan(s) other than the Dealer/Artisan whose names appear on the contract.
2. Items commercially manufactured by someone other than the Dealer/Artisan, where only repackaging and/or instructions may be added.

Please read the contract carefully, sign and return Page 2 to me. We look forward to another great show!
